2004 Fact Sheet

The **2004 Chile (Region V) GSHS** measured dietary behaviors; hygiene; unintentional injuries and violence; mental health; tobacco use; alcohol and other drug use; sexual behaviors; physical activity; and protective factors.

The 2004 Chile (Region V) GSHS was a school-based survey of students aged 13-15 years. A two-stage cluster sample design was used to produce representative data for 13-15 year old students in Chile (Region V). At the first stage, schools were selected with probability proportional to enrollment size. At the second stage, classes were randomly selected and all students in selected classes were eligible to participate. The school response rate was 100%, the student response rate was 86%, and the overall response rate was 86%. A total of 2,016 students participated in the Chile (Region V) GSHS.
